REACH Renton's Family Emergency Shelter and Meal Site provided a safe and secure environment for hundreds of people and families facing homelessness. A YEAR WITH UNIQUE CHALLENGES

Combining the day and night shelter into a 24-hour space, we saw a need and desire to build a plan to help homeless children. Particularly those who experience chronic or repeated episodes of homelessness are more likely to experience a substantial effect on their mental health.

This may result in behavioral issues, PTSD, developmental delays, drug abuse, anxiety, and depression. To assist them in overcoming their difficulties and forming a better future; offering homeless children and their families mental health programs is essential in the effort to end generational homelessness.

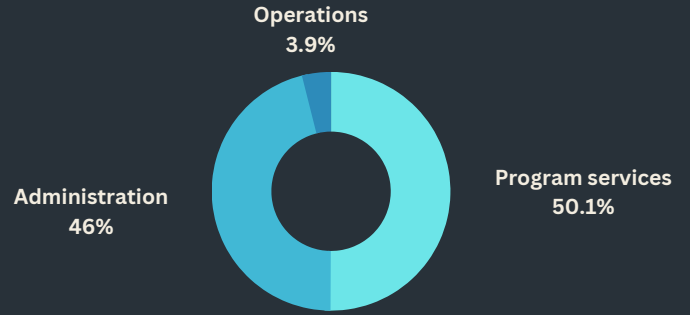
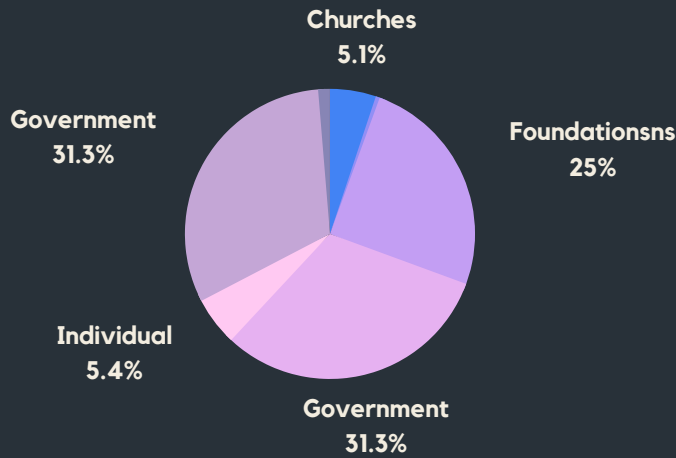

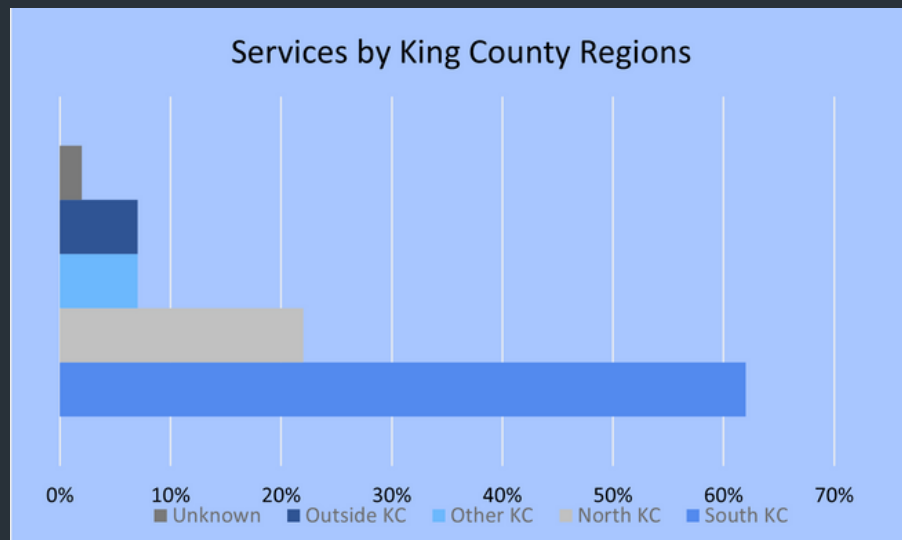
